**Term & Conditions for Tender:**

Tender will be opened in the presence of authorized representative of bidders, if they present themselves. Each of these instructions must be carefully read and followed strictly; failure in complying with any of these would render your offer for rejection.

1. The Supplier should have a registered shop/office in Leh-Ladakh.
2. The offer should be in sealed envelope and preferably sent by Registered Post/ Speed post  
Intending bidders are advised to post their offers well in time so as to reach us before bid due date and time. Offers sent through courier / by hand shall not be accepted if presented

after the due date and time for submission of bids. The offer would be in two sealed envelopes comprising technical bid including earnest money deposit and financial bid. These should be sealed and super scribed as “Technical Bid for Supplying/Manufacturing of furniture stated above”.

The two envelopes should be put in another envelope and sealed and sent to **Office of the Conservator of Forests, (Wildlife), Ladakh Leh 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Block 2<sup>nd</sup>, Council Secretariat, Leh Ladakh, 194101 J&K** as indicated in the Para before. The eligibility terms are given below:

- a) The Tenderer should be a professionally qualified furniture designer/manufacturer and should have expertise of manufacturing furniture as per the dimensions given by the office. Documentation in Support should be included in the technical bid.
  - b) The Tenderer should have proven experience in manufacturing of furniture Necessary documentation in support should be included in the technical bid.
3. Offer must be preferably typed and submitted in duplicate.
  4. The enquiry No, Bid due date and details of earnest money deposited (EMD) should be super scribed on the envelope, failing which the offer may be rejected. The requirement and specifications of the requirements should be as per Annexure 1.
  5. The quoted price must be written in both figures and words in capital letters. Alteration if any should be made clearly by crossing the whole entered rate and last correction should be attested by the tenderer with their full signature and rubber stamp. In no case there should be overwriting and all tenders with such overwriting shall be liable for rejection, In case of any discrepancy between figures and words, the rates on words shall be considered for the purpose of evaluation.
  6. Offers shall be accompanied with earnest money deposit (EMD) of requisite value as Specified in a separate envelope failing which offers are liable for rejection. EMD of Rs. 1000/- (one thousand rupees only) is to be furnished in form of Demand Draft in favour of **“conservator of forests, (wildlife), ladakh leh”** payable at Leh.
  7. The rates shall be for total amount payable by **conservator of forests, (wildlife), ladakh leh** inclusive of all taxes, freight , travel cost etc.
  8. Offers should strictly be as per the detail of **Annexure** as spelt out in the enquiry. Any deviations shall be clearly spelt out; In case they are not spelt out it shall be taken for granted that the item has been offered strictly as per requirement given in the inquiry. Derivations are likely to render the tender non-considerable. Bidders are advised not to deviate.

9. **Office of the conservator of forests, (wildlife), ladakh leh** reserves the right to split / accept or reject any / all offer without assigning any reason thereof to increase / decrease the tendered quantity. The quoted rates, shall apply.
10. The tenderer should indicate time period for designing of the required furniture as per the Required specifications.
11. Order placed as result of this enquiry shall be subject to the purchaser's General purchaser's conditions.
12. Payment will be done within One month of handing over of the furniture.
13. Tenderer shall certify that the rates are as applicable to Govt. Depts. /Autonomous Bodies. (If applicable).
14. The quoted rates must be firm till the complete execution of the contract and must be valid for a period of three months from the date of opening of tenders for placement of order.
15. Any technical production defects / unsatisfactory workmanship / low performance of the Manufacturer and in case any deficiencies are found in the furniture shall be re worked or changes will be done free of cost.
16. Bidders may note that the due date and time of opening of tenders will be strictly adhered to and accordingly if they wish to be present themselves at the tender opening, they should bring necessary authorization letter from the company. However due to declaration of unexpected holidays or any unforeseen circumstance if the tenders are not opened on the due date, the same will be opened on the next working day.
17. In case any clause is not acceptable to the tenderer. The same should be brought out in the bid with a categorical confirmation that all other clauses are acceptable to the bidders. If no mention is made in this regard, It shall be presumed that all the clauses mentioned herein are acceptable to bidders. However, the conditional tenders are likely to be rejected.
18. The offers should be valid for a period of 90 days from the date of opening bid.

22. Payment will be made after completion of the requirements.
